



Fulfilling the Indiana  
**HEALTH**  
Requirement at LCHS



There are four ways to fulfill the Indiana Health requirement at LCHS:

1. **Traditional classroom setting during the school year:** Health has already been placed in upcoming sophomore schedules. This scheduled class would take place in first or second semester.
2. **Traditional classroom setting during the summer:**
  - The cost is \$50 charged to the student's book fees.
  - Register with your school counselor from May 1 - 12.
3. Through **Indiana Online Academy during the summer:**
  - Register for Health at [indianaonlineacademy.org](http://indianaonlineacademy.org) as an online course
  - Students would take this during the summer and be expected to complete in 6 weeks.
  - Testing is AT LCHS July 17-20.
  - The cost is \$50 paid to IOA.
  - Once a student is registered, the high school counselor receives an email, approves the registration, and takes the Health class out of the schedule.
4. Through an **LC online course during the school year:**
  - This will be run as a pilot for the 2017-18 school year.
  - Students will have from August 2017 to April 2018 to complete the course
  - Pilot program registration will be limited to 150 students.
  - Registration will be through the student's school counselor beginning May 1 until filled.
  - The cost is \$50 charged to the student's book fees.
  - Students will complete the course on their own time: Examples include study hall, PtE, or after school.
  - Students will be expected to attend E122 during PtE/Academic Assistance to have tests unlocked and speak to their teacher, if needed.
