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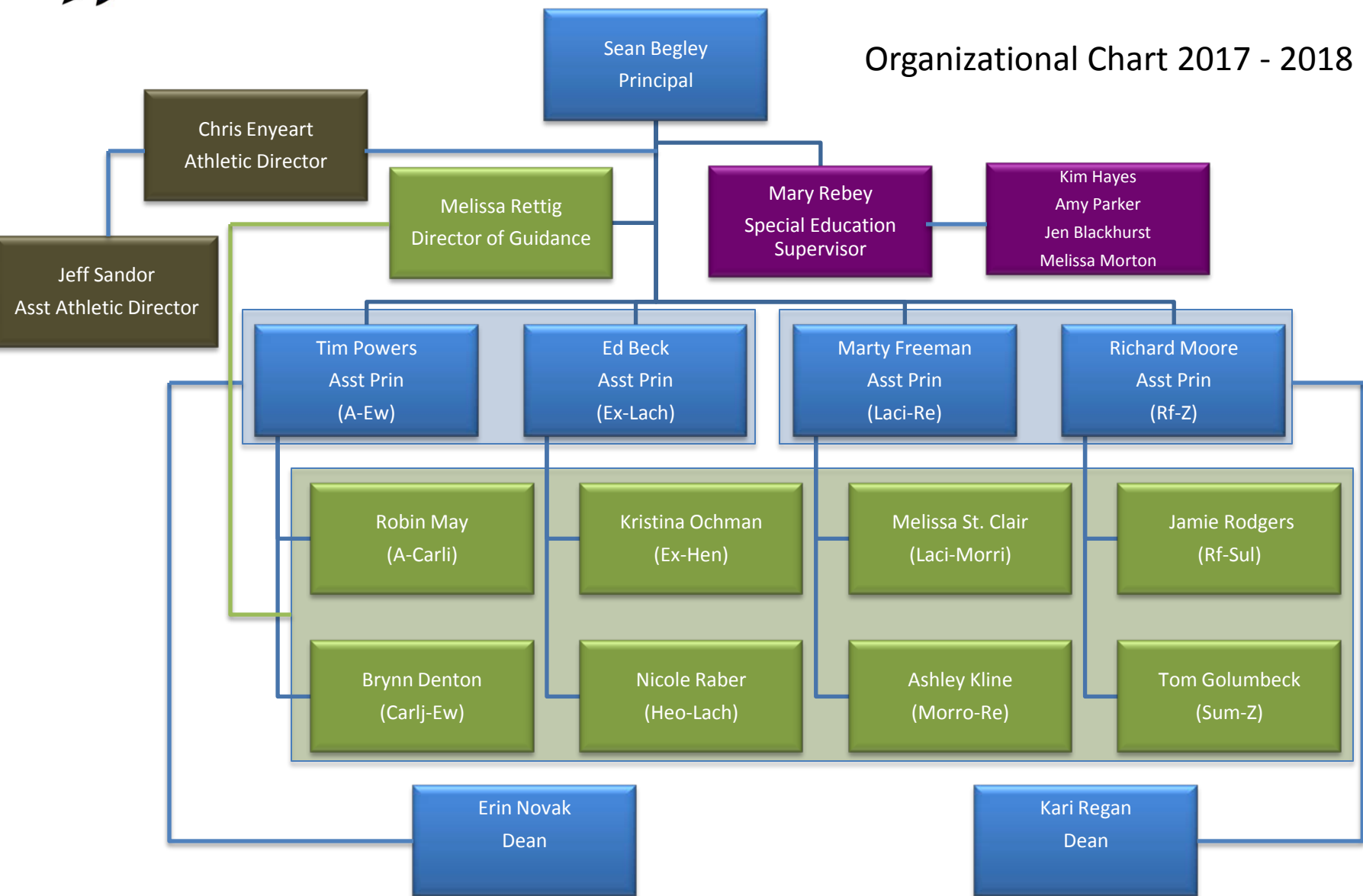

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Freshman Year – A Year of Change

- Our students enter as adolescents and leave as adults
 - Freshmen year you become a young adult
- New People - Teachers, 3 Middle Schools + Private & Parochial Schools Consolidate, Counselors, Principals, and Academic Team
- Facilities – 880,000 square foot campus
- Schedule – Modified - Block schedule
- Programs – Clubs, Athletics, Dances, Arts – During much of the year, there are students in the building for 17 hours out of a 24 hour day
- Early start time – 7:15am

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Freshman Year – Challenges

- Finding the balance - *Academically Challenged* while *Academically Successful*
- Earning High School Credits
- Transcript - The grades a student earns freshmen year are used by colleges in order to determine admission
- Six Semesters, not Eight Semesters = Magic Minute
- Adjusting to High School
- Graduation Qualifying Exam – English (10) and Mathematics (9)

***World Language (Spanish, German, French) – College Requirement

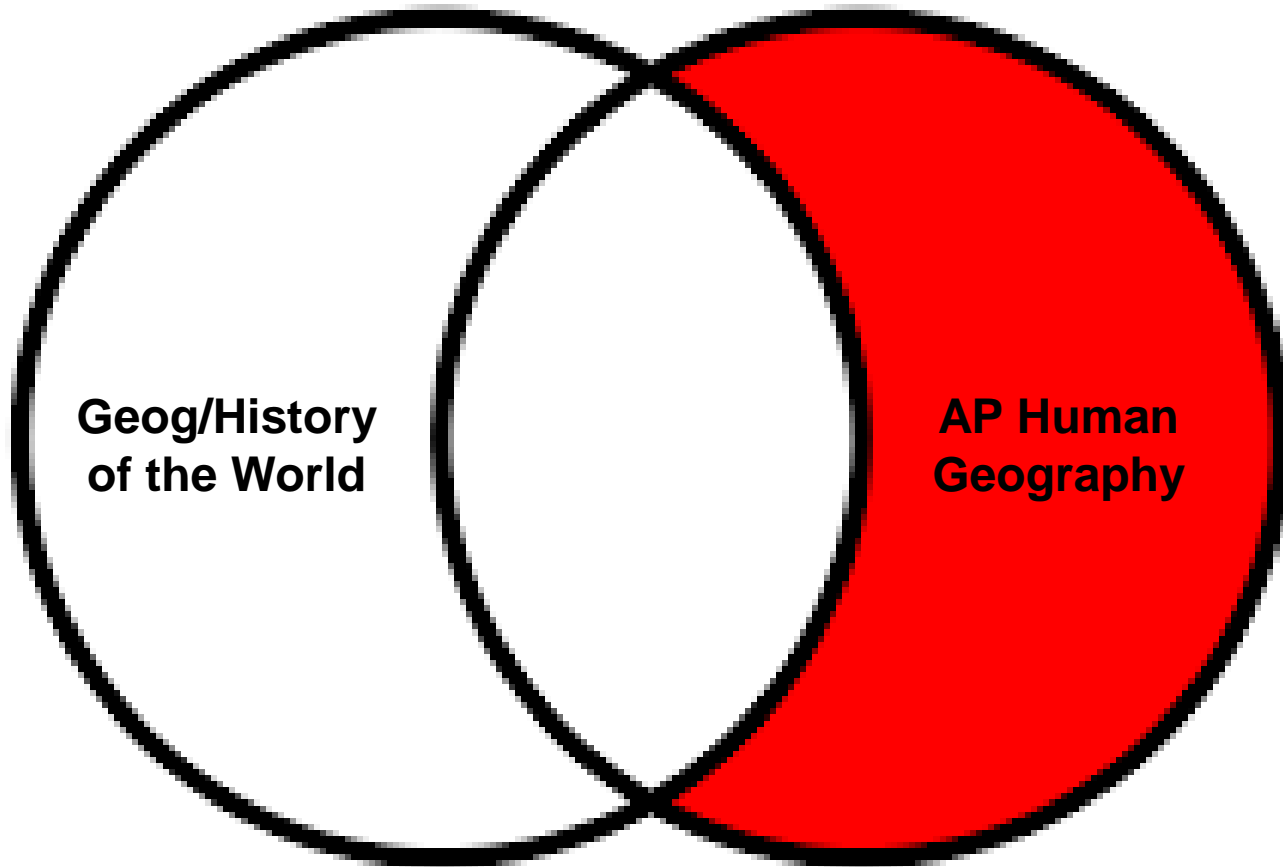

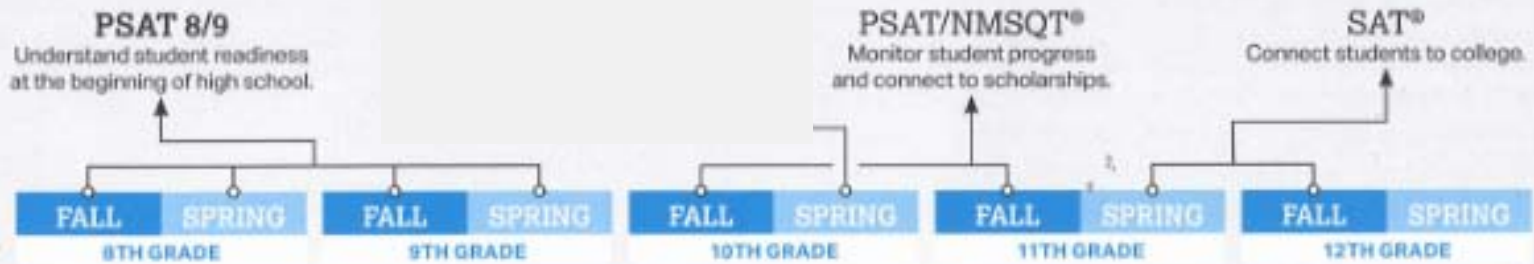

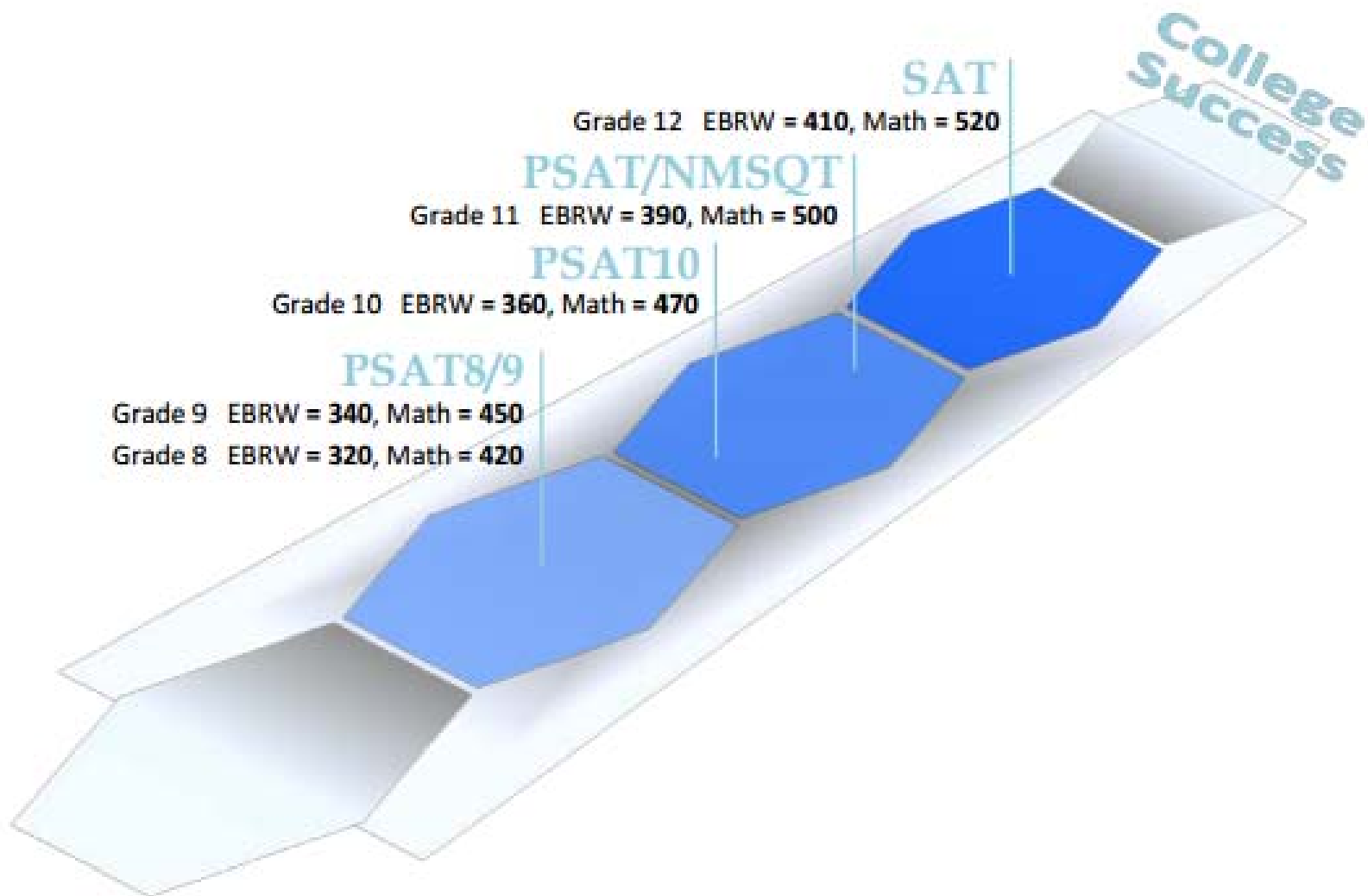
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Longitudinal Testing Resulting in a College Entrance Exam

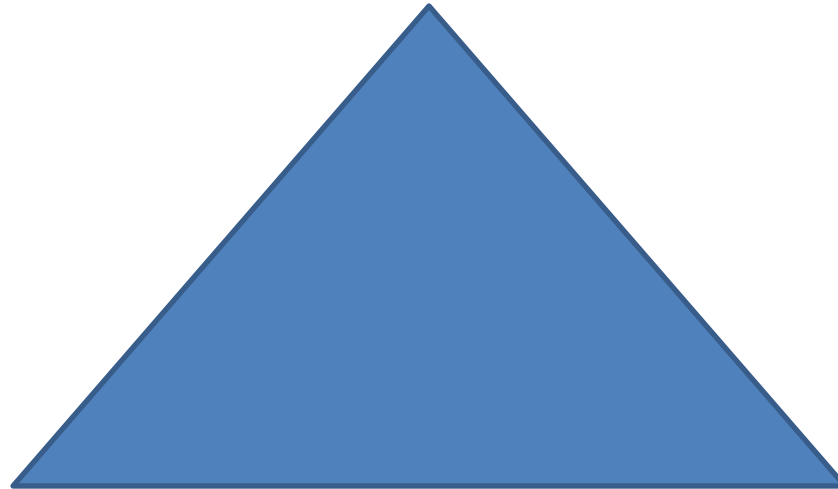
