COVID-19 Prevention Tip: Remember these important COVID-19 terms:

- **Quarantine:** This is a precaution for someone who is a close contact (within 6 feet for 15 minutes or more) with another person that has tested positive for COVID-19. People that are quarantined should stay home as much as possible as they have been exposed to a positive case and may also get COVID-19. The current CDC guidance for a COVID-19 quarantine is 14 days from the date of exposure.
- **Isolation:** A person put in isolation is someone that has tested positive for COVID-19 and can spread the virus. Isolated people should stay at home with minimal exposure with other family members. The current CDC guidance for COVID isolation is 10 days from the day of symptoms if symptomatic or 10 days from the date of COVID test is asymptomatic. In addition, people should not return to school unless they are completely symptom free for at least 24 hours prior to the end of the 10-day isolation period.
